Outcomes to date: June 2014 – September 2016

RPLC has met its objectives and in several ways exceeded them to date:

- Infrastructure established and functioning
- On budget and exceeding SSHRC's targets for partner contributions with \$372,000 in partner contributions over the first 2 years (2 year target from SSHRC was \$250K)
- 31 partnering institutions across 8 provinces in Canada and 6 other countries including 18 formal MOUs signed with Brandon University (6 of which are with international institutions)
- 65 participants from academia and government institutions across Canada
- 7 International Rural Policy Conferences, 2 Rural Policy workshops and 1 Rural Policy Symposium supported
- 3 Summer Institutes (Mexico, Ireland, and Alaska)
- 27 Webinars
- 139 Rural Policy books, articles, presentations (as of end of March 2016)
